- a. Status of EDA short-term planning grant for creation of a CEDS Dave updated the board that Amador County is now back in CSEDD according to the EDA. CSEDD will revisit joining the EDA and the short-term planning grant application is now back on track.
- b. Status of USDA Rural Business Development Grant Biomass feasibility study A contract is in hand is 99% complete. It will be completed by the April 30 deadline.

 Ben Stopper stressed the importance of regionalization moving forward and working together as the pandemic continues. Cole Przybyla announced an Economic Summit on December 7th and a rural business event on January 28th for Tuolumne County. Kathy Gallino notified the board that Calaveras has been awarded a grant for small business loans and business assistance. Tara Schiff shared that Mariposa County has received multiple grants for business assistance. Jamie Armstrong announced that Amador County is currently going through their CED planning and received PPE supplies to distribute to local businesses at not cost to them. Dave also notified the board of 3 current COVID assistance grants through Mother Lode Job Training for job seekers and businesses and a grant opportunity to do training for the region.
